Q1. On what mountain were the Ten Commandments given?

Answer: B. Mount Sinai

God spake all these words, saying... on mount Sinai. (Exodus 20:1, KJV)

Q2. What did God write them on?

Answer: B. Tables of stone

He gave unto Moses... two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God. (Exodus 31:18, KJV)

Q3. What is the first commandment?

Answer: B. Thou shalt have no other gods before me

Thou shalt have no other gods before me. (Exodus 20:3, KJV)

Q4. What does the second commandment forbid?

Answer: B. Graven images / idols

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image... thou shalt not bow down thyself to them. (Exodus 20:4, KJV)

Q5. What is the third commandment?

Answer: B. Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain

Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain. (Exodus 20:7, KJV)

Q6. What day is the Sabbath?

Answer: B. The seventh day

Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy... the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God. (Exodus 20:8, KJV)

Q7. Which commandment carries a promise?

Answer: B. Honour thy father and thy mother

Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. (Exodus 20:12, KJV)

Q8. What does the eighth commandment forbid?

Answer: B. Stealing

Thou shalt not steal. (Exodus 20:15, KJV)

Q9. What does the ninth commandment forbid?

Answer: B. Bearing false witness

Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour. (Exodus 20:16, KJV)

Q10. Where did Moses place the tablets after receiving them the second time?

Answer: A. In the ark of the covenant

There was nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb. (1 Kings 8:9, KJV)
