Q1. What did Jesus pray for all believers?

Answer: A. That they all may be one

That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. (John 17:21) (John 17:21, KJV)

Q2. How does Psalm 133 describe brethren dwelling together in unity?

Answer: A. It is like the precious ointment upon the head

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments. (Psalm 133:1-2) (Psalms 133:1, KJV)

Q3. What does Paul say there is one of in Ephesians 4?
