**Q1. What does James 1:2 tell us to do when we fall into divers temptations?**

**Answer:** B. Count it all joy

My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. (James 1:2, KJV)

**Q2. What does 1 Peter 1:7 say trials do for faith?**

**Answer:** B. Tried with fire, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth

That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 1:7, KJV)

**Q3. What does Romans 5:3 say we glory in?**

**Answer:** B. Tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience

And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience. (Romans 5:3, KJV)
