Q1. Of what people was Uriah?

Answer: B. Hittite

2 Samuel 11:3 (KJV) — 'Uriah the Hittite.' (2 Samuel 11:3, KJV)

Q2. Whose husband was Uriah?

Answer: C. Bathsheba

2 Samuel 11:3 (KJV) — 'Bath-sheba... the wife of Uriah the Hittite.' (2 Samuel 11:3, KJV)

Q3. At what city was Uriah fighting?

Answer: B. Rabbah

2 Samuel 11:1 (KJV) — Joab 'besieged Rabbah.' (2 Samuel 11:1, KJV)

Q4. Where did Uriah sleep when sent home?

Answer: B. At the door of the king's house with the servants

2 Samuel 11:9 (KJV) — 'Uriah slept at the door of the king's house.' (2 Samuel 11:9, KJV)

Q5. Why would Uriah not go home?

Answer: A. The army was in the field

2 Samuel 11:11 (KJV) — 'shall I then go into mine house, to eat and to drink...?' (2 Samuel 11:11, KJV)

Q6. What did David send by Uriah's hand to Joab?

Answer: B. A letter

2 Samuel 11:14 (KJV) — 'David wrote a letter to Joab, and sent it by the hand of Uriah.' (2 Samuel 11:14, KJV)

Q7. What did the letter command?

Answer: B. Set him in the forefront of the hottest battle

2 Samuel 11:15 (KJV). (2 Samuel 11:15, KJV)

Q8. Who slew Uriah?

Answer: C. The men of the city of Rabbah

2 Samuel 11:17 (KJV) — 'the men of the city... Uriah the Hittite died also.' (2 Samuel 11:17, KJV)

Q9. Whom did Nathan say David had killed with the sword?

Answer: B. Uriah

2 Samuel 12:9 (KJV) — 'thou hast killed Uriah the Hittite with the sword.' (2 Samuel 12:9, KJV)

Q10. Uriah's wife is named in the genealogy of whom?

Answer: C. Jesus Christ

Matthew 1:6 (KJV) — 'David the king begat Solomon of her that had been the wife of Urias.' (Matthew 1:6, KJV)
