Q1. What was Zacchaeus' occupation?

Answer: B. A chief among the publicans / chief tax collector

And, behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich. (Luke 19:2, KJV)

Q2. Why couldn't Zacchaeus see Jesus?

Answer: A. The crowd was too great, and he was little of stature

And he sought to see Jesus who he was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature. (Luke 19:3, KJV)

Q3. What did Zacchaeus climb to see Jesus?

Answer: C. A sycamore tree

And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see him: for he was to pass that way. (Luke 19:4, KJV)

Q4. What did Jesus say to Zacchaeus when he saw him in the tree?

Answer: A. Come down, for to day I must abide at thy house

And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house. (Luke 19:5, KJV)

Q5. How did the people react when Jesus went to Zacchaeus' house?

Answer: B. They murmured, saying He was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner

And when they saw it, they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner. (Luke 19:7, KJV)

Q6. What did Zacchaeus promise to give to the poor?

Answer: B. Half of his goods

And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor. (Luke 19:8, KJV)

Q7. What did Zacchaeus promise to restore if he had taken anything by false accusation?

Answer: C. Fourfold

And if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold. (Luke 19:8, KJV)

Q8. What did Jesus say had come to Zacchaeus' house?

Answer: C. Salvation

And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forasmuch as he also is a son of Abraham. (Luke 19:9, KJV)

Q9. What did Jesus call Zacchaeus?

Answer: B. A son of Abraham

He also is a son of Abraham. Zacchaeus, though despised, was of the covenant people and eligible for grace. (Luke 19:9, KJV)

Q10. What did Jesus say was the purpose of His coming?

Answer: B. To seek and to save that which was lost

For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost. (Luke 19:10, KJV)
