Q1. Whose brother was Zedekiah?

Answer: B. Jehoiakim

2 Kings 24:17 (KJV) — Mattaniah, the brother (uncle to Jehoiachin), made king in his stead. (2 Kings 24:17, KJV)

Q2. What was Zedekiah's name before the king of Babylon changed it?

Answer: A. Mattaniah

2 Kings 24:17 (KJV) — 'changed his name to Zedekiah.' (2 Kings 24:17, KJV)

Q3. How old was Zedekiah when he began to reign?

Answer: B. 21

2 Kings 24:18 (KJV) — 'twenty and one years old.' (2 Kings 24:18, KJV)

Q4. How long did Zedekiah reign?

Answer: C. 11 years

2 Kings 24:18 (KJV) — 'reigned eleven years in Jerusalem.' (2 Kings 24:18, KJV)

Q5. Against whom did Zedekiah rebel?

Answer: C. Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon

2 Kings 24:20 (KJV) — 'Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.' (2 Kings 24:20, KJV)

Q6. Who urged Zedekiah to submit to Babylon?

Answer: B. Jeremiah

Jeremiah 38:17 (KJV) — Jeremiah counselled surrender to the king of Babylon's princes. (Jeremiah 38:17, KJV)

Q7. How was Zedekiah captured?

Answer: B. He fled by night and was overtaken in the plains of Jericho

2 Kings 25:4-5 (KJV) — 'overtook him in the plains of Jericho.' (2 Kings 25:5, KJV)

Q8. What was the last thing Zedekiah saw?

Answer: B. The slaying of his sons

2 Kings 25:7 (KJV) — 'they slew the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes.' (2 Kings 25:7, KJV)

Q9. What was then done to Zedekiah?

Answer: B. His eyes were put out, and he was bound with fetters of brass

2 Kings 25:7 (KJV). (2 Kings 25:7, KJV)

Q10. To what city was Zedekiah carried?

Answer: B. Babylon

2 Kings 25:7 (KJV) — 'carried him to Babylon.' (2 Kings 25:7, KJV)
